THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACT

THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS (PRESCRIBED EQUIPMENT) ORDER, 2002

In exercise of the power conferred on the Minister by section 72 of the Telecommunications Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Telecommunications (Prescribed Equipment) Order, 2002.
- 2.—(1) Any equipment which when used to make telephone calls—
 - (a) circumvents the international network of a licensed international voice carrier; or
 - (b) does not use the services of a licensed domestic voice service provider,is designated as prescribed equipment.

PROCLAMATIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS [FEB. 6, 2002

(2) Nothing in this Order, shall apply to computer equipment whose primary use is not to provide voice services.
